



## MEDICAL FORM GUIDELINES

In order for us to provide the best possible care for you while you are in the HEC Paris MBA, it is important for us to be aware of your medical history.

Therefore, we kindly request that you fill out the medical form and **bring it with you on your first week on campus**. This form is entirely confidential and only the school doctor will have access to it.

### A. MEDICAL EMERGENCY FORM AND MEDICAL BACKGROUND

Please fill out page 1 of the medical form with your intake year, program, name, and emergency contact. Please ensure you have signed the bottom of the page.

On **page 2** of the medical form, we ask that your local doctor notify us of your medical history, allergies, and any medication you need. For example, we need to know if you have diabetes, epilepsy, or are allergic to a drug type such as penicillin. We understand that this might not always be possible, especially if your doctor does not speak English.

In this case, you may exceptionally fill out page 2 of the form yourself, but your doctor must sign, date, and stamp the bottom of the page.

### B. VACCINATIONS

Currently in France you do not need proof of any vaccinations when you enter the country, but the diphtheria/tetanus/polio vaccine is mandatory when you live in France. We strongly recommend that you are up to date with the vaccinations listed before you start your MBA, and we encourage you to check your medical history and vaccination record. Once you have arrived on campus, we will also inform you about the vaccination requirements issued by the OFII (Office Français de l'Immigration et de l'Intégration) that you will need when renewing your visa.

### C. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE TO PRACTICE COMPETITIVE SPORTS

By law in France, you are required to obtain a medical certificate to practice competitive sports (such as a football tournament, marathon, or to join a gym) for insurance purposes. You will be required to have this form to use the HEC Paris gym and athletic fields on campus. Please have your doctor sign the form to approve you are in good health for playing sports before you arrive. Again, if your doctor does not speak English, you can fill it out yourself, but it must be signed, dated, and stamped by a certified doctor.
